An Honors Thesis Lecture Recital Addressing Homelessness

In fulfillment of her Honors Thesis and Senior Recital requirements, USC senior SAMANTHA CRANDALL will present a lecture recital addressing homelessness.

The lecture portion will focus on the statistics, causes, and solutions of homelessness both on a local and national level.

The musical portion will explore the emotional journey that an individual who is homeless may experience. This will include a performance of *Figment*, for soprano, flute, cello and piano by Meira Warshauer, with text by Jack Burkheimer, who has personally experienced homelessness in Columbia. There will also be music by Tchaikovsky and Mozart.

Immediately afterwards, there will be a reception with the opportunity for attendants to converse with representatives from different organizations addressing homelessness.
